- 1. Documentation provides written account of activities as they happen.**
- 2. Stands as written proof that something was done or said.**

****Homemade Ice Cream****

Ingredients-

Ice cubes, 1 C half & half, 1/2 C kosher salt, 2 TBS sugar, 1/2 TSP vanilla extract, 1 pint ziplock bag, 1 gallon ziplock bag.

Directions- Combine half & half, sugar, vanilla extract in the pint size bag and seal tightly.

Fill gallon bag halfway with ice cubes and sprinkle the salt over ice cubes. Put pint bag into gallon bag & seal the bag. Shake the bag for 5-10 mins until ice cream mixture begins to harden. Feel small bag to determine the consistency of your ice cream. Once satisfied, remove the small bag and enjoy!
